Matrimurtis and Matridevis of Mathura and associated sites
(in englischer Sprache)

von Prof. Seema Bawa (University of Delhi)

Der Vortrag findet wie gewohnt im Vortragsraum des Museums für Asiatische Kunst,
Takustrasse 40, statt.

Mathura sculptures found at Govindgarh, Maholi, Naroli, Sonkh, Kankali Tila and
associated sites such as Sanghol provide a sculptural corpus with a thematic
emphasis on images of so called *yakshis/yakshinis* in various postures and states. In
this talk an interpretation of the 'Women and Child' compositions and their
interrelationship with Goddess figures will be attempted. This would include the
notions of biological and social mothering, maternity within the discourse of
saundarya, (aesthetically pleasing forms) and divine feminine.

Seema Bawa is Professor at the Department of History, University of Delhi.
